#### **Sea Fisheries Act 1968 (c.77)**

**5.** In section 10 of the Sea Fisheries Act 1968 (miscellaneous provisions as to sea-fishery officers)<sup>(1)</sup>, in subsection (4), for the words following “liable” substitute “on summary conviction, or on conviction on indictment, to a fine”.
