The Hornsea Two Offshore Wind Farm (Correction) Order 2016

Made---16th November 2016Coming into force-17th November 2016

The Hornsea Two Offshore Wind Farm Order  $2016(\mathbf{a})$  (the "Order"), which granted development consent within the meaning of the Planning Act  $2008(\mathbf{b})$  (the "Act"), contained correctable errors within the meaning of the Act.

In accordance with paragraph 1(5)(a) of Schedule 4 to the Act, the Secretary of State received, before the end of the relevant period referred to in paragraph 1(6)(a) of that Schedule, a written request from SMart Wind Limited to correct errors and omissions in the Order. In accordance with paragraph 1(7) of that Schedule, the Secretary of State informed East Lindsey District Council, North East Lincolnshire Council, North Lincolnshire Council, West Lindsey District Council and Lincolnshire Council that the request had been received.

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers in paragraph 1(4) and (8) of that Schedule, makes the following Order:

#### Citation and commencement

**1.**—(1) This Order may be cited as the Hornsea Two Offshore Wind Farm (Correction) Order 2016.

(2) This Order comes into force on 17th November 2016.
