Variable message signs

PART 4

Legends indicating location of temporary hazard or incident

5. One of the following legends may be used on a variable message sign in conjunction (either on its own or in combination with a legend provided for in Part 5) with a legend provided for in Part 3—

- (a) a route number;
- (b) “ON [name of bridge] BRIDGE” or “ON BRIDGE”;
- (c) “AT” together with—
 - (i) a place name,
 - (ii) the name of a bridge or tunnel,
 - (iii) a junction name or number or a junction number and “EXIT”, or
 - (iv) “NEXT JCT” or “TOLL”;
- (d) “AFTER” together with—
 - (i) a place name,
 - (ii) the name of a bridge or tunnel,
 - (iii) “BRIDGE” or “TUNNEL”,
 - (iv) a junction name or number, or
 - (v) “NEXT JCT”;
- (e) a number and “MILES”;
- (f) “AHEAD” preceded by a legend specified in paragraph 3(2)(v) or (w) only;
- (g) “FOR” together with a number and “MILES”;
- (h) “IN ROAD”;
- (i) a junction number;
- (j) a junction number “TO” and another junction number;
- (k) “ON SLIP ROAD”;
- (l) “TO” and a route number.
