## PART 1

### AMENDMENT TO SECONDARY LEGISLATION TO INSERT REFERENCE TO THE “DIRECTOR OF LABOUR MARKET ENFORCEMENT”

#### **Amendment of the Official Secrets Act 1989 (Prescription) Order 1990**

1. In the Official Secrets Act 1989 (Prescription) Order 1990(a), at the end of Schedule 2 (prescriptions: section 12(1)(g)), insert—

“Director of Labour Market Enforcement | —”.

2. In Part 1 of the Schedule to the Legislative and Regulatory Reform (Regulatory Functions) Order 2007(b), in the table, for “Gangmasters Licensing Authority” substitute “Gangmasters Labour and Abuse Authority”.

#### **Amendment of the Regulation of Investigatory Powers (Authorisations Extending to Scotland) Order 2007**

3. In the Schedule to the Regulation of Investigatory Powers (Authorisations Extending to Scotland) Order 2007(c), for “The Gangmasters Licensing Authority” substitute “The Gangmasters Labour and Abuse Authority”.

#### **Amendment of the Companies (Disclosure of Address) Regulations 2009**

4. In Schedule 1 to the Companies (Disclosure of Address) Regulations 2009(d) (specified public authorities), for “the Gangmasters Licensing Authority” substitute “the Gangmasters Labour and Abuse Authority”.

#### **Amendment of the Overseas Companies Regulations 2009**

5. In Schedule 1 to the Overseas Companies Regulations 2009(e) (specified public authorities), for “the Gangmasters Licensing Authority” substitute “the Gangmasters Labour and Abuse Authority”.

6. In Schedule 1 to the Proceeds of Crime Act 2002 (References to Financial Investigators) Order 2009 (a), in column 2 of the table, for “the Gangmasters Licensing Authority” in each place where it appears substitute “the Gangmasters Labour and Abuse Authority”.

### **Amendment of the Regulation of Investigatory Powers (Communications Data) Order 2010**

7. In Part 1 of Schedule 2 to the Regulation of Investigatory Powers (Communications Data) Order 2010(b) (offices, ranks and positions in additional relevant public authorities specified by this Order), in the first column of the table, for “The Gangmasters Licensing Authority” substitute “The Gangmasters Labour and Abuse Authority”.

### **Amendment of the Regulation of Investigatory Powers (Directed Surveillance and Covert Human Intelligence Sources) Order 2010**

8. In Part 1 of the Schedule to the Regulation of Investigatory Powers (Directed Surveillance and Covert Human Intelligence Sources) Order 2010(c) (prescribed offices etc. in relevant public authorities and restrictions on authorisations), in the first column of the table, for “The Gangmasters Licensing Authority” substitute “The Gangmasters Labour and Abuse Authority”.

### **Amendment of the Disclosure (Persons engaged in the Investigation and Reporting of Crime or Sudden Deaths) (Scotland) Regulations 2011**

9. In the Schedule to the Disclosure (Persons engaged in the Investigation and Reporting of Crime or Sudden Deaths) (Scotland) Regulations 2011(d), for “Gangmasters Licensing Authority” substitute “Gangmasters Labour and Abuse Authority”.

### **Amendment of the Companies (Disclosure of Date of Birth Information) Regulations 2015**

10. In Schedule 1 to the Companies (Disclosure of Date of Birth Information) Regulations 2015(e) (specified public authorities), for “the Gangmasters Licensing Authority” substitute “the Gangmasters Labour and Abuse Authority”.

### **Amendment of the Proceeds of Crime Act 2002 (References to Financial Investigators) (England and Wales) Order 2015**

11. In the Schedule to the Proceeds of Crime Act 2002 (References to Financial Investigators) (England and Wales) Order 2015(f), in column 2 of the table, for “the Gangmasters Licensing Authority” in each place where it appears substitute “the Gangmasters Labour and Abuse Authority”.

### **Amendment of the Register of People with Significant Control Regulations 2016**

12. In Schedule 3 to the Register of People with Significant Control Regulations 2016(g) (specified public authorities), for “the Gangmasters Licensing Authority” substitute “the Gangmasters Labour and Abuse Authority”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of these Regulations)*

These Regulations make amendments to secondary legislation which are consequential to changes made by Part 1 of the Immigration Act 2016 (c.19). Regulation 2 introduces a Schedule containing those consequential amendments.

Part 1 of the Schedule inserts a reference to the “Director of Labour Market Enforcement” into Schedule 2 to the Official Secrets Act 1989 (Prescription) Order 1990. This prescribes certain persons for the purposes of the Official Secrets Act 1989, the effect of which is that those persons who are prescribed become Crown servants for all purposes of the Act.

Part 2 of the Schedule amends secondary legislation to replace references to the “Gangmasters Licensing Authority” with references to the “Gangmasters and Labour Abuse Authority”.

A full impact assessment has not been produced for this instrument as these Regulations do not themselves have any impact on the private, voluntary or public sectors.
