**Additional functions**

**Incidental provisions**

**13.** The following provisions have effect in relation to the Combined Authority as if it were a local authority—

- (a) section 113 of the Local Government Act 1972(power to place staff at the disposal of other local authorities)(**1**);
- (b) section 142(2) of the Local Government Act 1972 (power to arrange for publication of information etc relating to the functions of the authority)(**2**); and
- (c) section 222 of the Local Government Act 1972 (power to prosecute and defend legal proceedings)(**3**).
