Amendment of the Blood Safety and Quality Regulations 2005

- **2.** In regulation 1 (citation, commencement and interpretation) of the Blood Safety and Quality Regulations 2005(1), in paragraph (3)—
 - (a) in the definition of "care home" (2)—
 - (i) in paragraph (a), omit "and Wales";
 - (ii) at the end of paragraph (b), omit "and";
 - (iii) in paragraph (c), after "2003" insert—
 - ", and
 - (d) in Wales, means a place at which a care home service, within the meaning of Paragraph 1 of Schedule 1 of the Regulation and Inspection of Social Care (Wales) Act 2016(3), is provided wholly or mainly to persons aged 18 or over";
 - (b) in the definition of "registered person" (4)—
 - (i) at the end of paragraph (a), omit "and";
 - (ii) in paragraph (b), omit "Wales,";
 - (iii) at the end of paragraph (b), insert—

"and

- (c) in Wales,—
 - (i) the person registered with Social Care Wales(5) as the manager of a place at which a care home service, within the meaning of Paragraph 1 of Schedule 1 of the Regulation and Inspection of Social Care (Wales) Act 2016, is provided wholly or mainly to persons aged 18 or over(6), or
