**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Headcorn)  
(Amendment) Regulations 2018**

*Made* - - - - *17th April 2018*

*Coming into force* - - *12th May 2018*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Lashenden/Headcorn Aerodrome, Kent by reason of the intended holding of flying displays that are scheduled to take place there.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016(a).

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Headcorn) (Amendment) Regulations 2018 and come into force on 12th May 2018.

**Amendment**

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Headcorn) Regulations 2018(b) are amended as follows.

3. In regulation 3(1)—

- (a) omit sub-paragraph (a), and
- (b) in sub-paragraph (b), for “1100” substitute “1000”.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Headcorn) Regulations 2018 (S.I. 2018/114) (“the principal Regulations”). The amendment cancels the restrictions of flying on

---

(a) S.I. 2016/765, to which there are amendments not relevant to these Regulations.  
(b) S.I. 2018/114.

12th and 13th May 2018 and amends the times of the restrictions of flying on 30th June and 1st July 2018 at Lashenden/Headcorn Aerodrome, Kent.

Full details of the amendment will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular (AIC) and Notice to Airmen (NOTAM).
