The Town and Country Planning (Precommencement Conditions) Regulations 2018

Citation, commencement, application and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Town and Country Planning (Pre-commencement Conditions) Regulations 2018 and come into force on 1st October 2018.
- (2) These Regulations apply to pre-commencement conditions(1) imposed on a grant(2) of planning permission which is granted on or after 1st October 2018.
 - (3) In these Regulations—
 - "a substantive response" means a response which—
 - (i) states that the applicant does not agree to the imposition of the proposed condition, or
 - (ii) provides comments on the proposed condition;

"working day" means a day which is not a Saturday, Sunday or public holiday (where "public holiday" means Christmas Day, Good Friday or a day which is a bank holiday in England under the Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971(3)).
