- **4.** In regulation 3 (interpretation) of the 2001 Regulations—
 - (a) in the definition of "official fuel consumption", for "Regulation (EC) No. 715/2007 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20th June 2007" substitute "Commission Regulation (EU) No. 2017/1151"(1); and
 - (b) in the definition of "official specific emissions of CO₂", for "Regulation (EC) No. 715/2007 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20th June 2007" substitute "Commission Regulation (EU) No. 2017/1151".
- **5.** In Schedule 2 (requirements for the fuel economy label) for Figure 1 substitute the following—
