The Equine Identification (England) Regulations 2018

PART 2

Administrative and procedural provisions and requirements

Applications for IDs

6.—(1) For the purposes of Articles 3(3) and 11(2), the owner of an equine [^{F1}born in a member State or in the United Kingdom] and located on a holding in England must ensure that an application for an ID for that equine is received by an issuing body on or before the date set out in paragraph (2).

- (2) The date is the later of—
 - (a) the last day of the period of 6 months beginning with the day on which the equine was born; or
 - (b) 30th November in the year in which the equine is born.
