ROAD TRAFFIC

The M6 Toll Motorway (Junction T1 to Junction T3) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2018

Made - 18th May 2018

Coming into force - 25th May 2018

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Toll Motorway ("the M6 Toll") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads, in the City of Birmingham and the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The M6 Toll Motorway (Junction T1 to Junction T3) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2018 and shall come into force on Friday 25th May 2018.

2. In this Order -

"a slip/link road" means any slip/link road leading to or from the

northbound and southbound carriageways of the M6 Toll

at Junctions T1, T2 and T3;

"the works period" means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Friday 1st

June 2018 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on a slip/link road.

- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
 - a) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
 - b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
 - c) being used in connection with the said works; or
 - d) being driven by, or at the direction of, a traffic officer in uniform.
