Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 28(1) of the Fire and Rescue Services Act 2004(1), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order as follows:

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Fire and Rescue Services (Appointment of Inspector) (Wales) Order 2018 and shall come into force on 1st July 2018.

Appointment of Inspector

2. Andrew John Fry is appointed an inspector for the purposes of section 28(1) of the Fire and Rescue Services Act 2004 in its application to Wales.

Revocation of appointment

3. The Fire and Rescue Services (Appointment of Inspector) (Wales) Order 2015(2) is revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order appoints Andrew John Fry as an inspector under section 28(1) of the Fire and Rescue Services Act 2004 in its application to Wales. An inspector is appointed under section 28(1) for the purpose of obtaining information as to (a) the manner in which fire and rescue authorities in Wales are discharging their functions and (b) technical matters relating to those functions.

It also revokes the 2015 Order which appointed his predecessor, Desmond George Tidbury.
