The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Music Festivals) (Amendment) Regulations 2018

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict the flying of unmanned aircraft by reason of the intended gathering of large numbers of persons at music festivals in the vicinity of Newquay, Reading, and Daresbury.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order $2016(\mathbf{a})$.

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Music Festivals) (Amendment) Regulations 2018 and come into force on 9th August 2018.

Amendment

2.—(1) The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Music Festivals) Regulations 2018 (**b**) are amended as follows—
