1. This Order may be cited as the North Western Inshore Fisheries and Conservation (Amendment) Order 2019 and comes into force on 27th September 2019.

2. In Part 1 of the Schedule to the North Western Inshore Fisheries and Conservation Order 2010(b), in the table, in the entry for point 15, in the second column (*Latitude*), for “53°” substitute “54°”.

This Order amends the Schedule to the North Western Inshore Fisheries and Conservation Order 2010 (S.I. 2010/2200) to correct a co-ordinate of latitude of a point on the northern boundary of the North Western Inshore Fisheries and Conservation district.

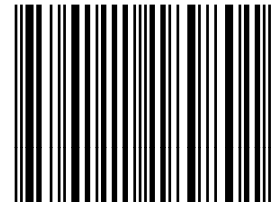
