**The M6 Toll Motorway (M6 Toll Junction T8 to M6 Junction
11a, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order
2019**

Made - - - - *11th November 2019*

Coming into force - - *18th November 2019*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Toll Motorway (“the M6 Toll”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway, in the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^(a), hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 Toll Motorway (M6 Toll Junction T8 to M6 Junction 11a, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2019 and shall come into force on Monday 18th November 2019.

2. In this Order —

“the motorway” means the northbound carriageway of the M6 Toll from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction T8 to its junction with the M6 at Junction 11A;

“the works period” means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Monday 25th November 2019 and ending when the said works have completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the motorway.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle—

- (a) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- (c) being used in connection with the said works;
- (d) being driven by, or at the direction of, a traffic officer in uniform; or
- (e) being used for winter maintenance purposes.
