The Office for Students, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 42(1) of the Higher Education and Research Act 2017(a), makes the following Order:

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Power to Award Degrees etc. (The London Interdisciplinary School Ltd) Order 2020 and shall come into force on 27th September 2021.

## Competence to grant awards

- **2.** The London Interdisciplinary School Ltd shall be competent to grant the following specified taught award of the kind mentioned in section 42(2)(b) of the said Act:
  - (a) BASc (Hons) in Interdisciplinary Problems and Methods.
- **3.** The London Interdisciplinary School Ltd shall only be competent to grant the specified taught award mentioned in paragraph 2 of this Order for a fixed term beginning on 27th September 2021 and expiring on 31st December 2024.
- **4.** The London Interdisciplinary School Ltd shall only grant the award specified in paragraph 2 of this Order to persons enrolled with it at the time they complete the course of study for which the award is granted.
