Any alien in whose case a Certificate has been given by a Court with 2 view to the making of an expulsion order under the Aliens Act, 1905, and 5 Edw. 7. c. 13 who is confined in any prison until the Secretary of State has decided upon his case, may be photographed and measured in the same way as a criminal prisoner; and the Regulations, dated 20th June, 1896,(a) made by the Secretary of State under Section 8 of the Penal Servitude Act, 1891, shall apply to such prisoners accordingly.
