**The National Health Service (Travelling Expenses and
Remission of Charges) Amendment (Wales) Regulations 1999**

Made - - - - 5th October 1999
Coming into Force - - 5th October 1999

The National Assembly for Wales makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred on the Secretary of State for Wales by sections 83A, 126(4) and 128(1) of the National Health Service Act 1977⁽¹⁾ and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf and now vested in the National Assembly for Wales⁽²⁾:

Section 126(4) was amended by section 65(2) of the 1990 Act. Section 128(1) is an interpretation provision and is cited because of the meanings assigned to the words “prescribed” and “regulations”; section 128(1) was amended by section 26(2)(g) and (i) of the 1990 Act.
- (2) The functions of the Secretary of State under section 83A, 126(4) and 128(1) of the National Health Service Act 1977 were transferred to the National Assembly for Wales (“the Assembly”) by the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999 (SI 1999/672).
