PART IV

Reference method for the sampling and measurement of PM₁₀

The reference method for the sampling and measurement of PM₁₀ will be that described in EN 12341 “Air Quality — Field Test Procedure to Demonstrate Reference Equivalence of Sampling Methods for the PM₁₀ fraction of particulate matter” (1). The measurement principle is based on the collection on a filter of the PM₁₀ fraction of ambient particulate matter and the gravimetric mass determination.
