The General Teaching Council for Wales (Constitution) (Amendment) Regulations 2003

Made - - - - 25th February 2003

Coming into force - - 17th March 2003

The National Assembly for Wales makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred on the Secretary of State by sections 1(5) and (7) of, and paragraph 3 of Schedule 1 to the Teaching and Higher Education Act 1998(1) and now vested in the National Assembly for Wales(2):

Name and commencement

1. These Regulations are called the General Teaching Council for Wales (Constitution) (Amendment) Regulations 2003 and shall come into force on 17th March 2003.

Amendment of the General Teaching Council for Wales (Constitution) Regulations 1999

- **2.**—(1) The General Teaching Council for Wales (Constitution) Regulations 1999(3) are amended as follows.
- (2) The Schedule to the General Teaching Council for Wales (Constitution) Regulations 1999 is replaced by the following Schedule —
