PART 4

PERSONS WHO PERFORM SERVICES

Conditions for employment and engagement

56.—(1) Subject to sub-paragraphs (2) and (3), a contractor shall not employ or engage a medical practitioner (other than one falling within paragraph 52(2)) unless—

- (a) that practitioner has provided it with the name and address of the Local Health Board on whose medical performers list the practitioner appears; and
- (b) the contractor has checked that the practitioner meets the requirements in paragraph 52.

(2) Where the employment or engagement of a medical practitioner is urgently needed and it is not possible for the contractor to check the matters referred to in paragraph 52 in accordance with sub-paragraph (1)(b) before employing or engaging the medical practitioner, the medical practitioner may be employed or engaged on a temporary basis for a single period of up to 7 days whilst such checks are undertaken.

(3) Where the prospective employee is a GP Registrar, the requirements set out in subparagraph (1) shall apply with the modifications that —

- (a) the name and address provided under sub-paragraph (1) may be the name and address of the Local Health Board on whose list the GP Registrar has applied for inclusion; and
- (b) confirmation that GP Registrar's name appears on that list shall not be required until the end of the first two months of the GP Registrar's training period.
