The National Assembly for Wales, in exercise of the power conferred upon it by section 56(1)(b) of the Care Standards Act 2000(1) and having consulted the Care Council for Wales(2), hereby makes the following Order:

### Citation, commencement and interpretation

**1.**—(1) This Order may be cited as the Care Council for Wales (Specification of Student Social Workers) (Registration) Order 2004 and comes into force on 1st April 2004.

(2) In this Order —

"the Act" ("y Ddeddf") means the Care Standards Act 2000;

"the Council" ("y Cyngor") means the Care Council for Wales;

"student social worker" ("*gweithiwr cymdeithasol o dan hyfforddiant*") means a person participating in a course approved by the Council under section 63 of the Act for persons wishing to become social workers.
