**The Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy
(BSE) Compensation (Wales) Regulations 2006**

Compensation for bovine animals slaughtered for TSE

3. The National Assembly must pay compensation—
- (a) when an animal is killed under Schedule 3 of the Transmissible Spongiform Encephalopathies (Wales) Regulations 2006;
 - (b) where an animal is to be killed under Schedule 3 of the Transmissible Spongiform Encephalopathies (Wales) Regulations 2006, and has been valued for the purposes of compensation, but dies (or is killed for other reasons) after valuation; or
 - (c) where an animal is subject to a movement restriction under Schedule 3 of the Transmissible Spongiform Encephalopathies (Wales) Regulations 2006 and has to be killed as an emergency and a veterinary surgeon has declared in writing that the animal would otherwise have been fit for human consumption in accordance with Chapter VI of Annex III to Regulation (EC) No 853/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down specific hygiene rules for food of animal origin⁽¹⁾ in which case compensation is the value of the body (including the blood and hide).
