**The Ceramic Articles in Contact
with Food (Wales) Regulations 2006**

Application of the Food Safety Act 1990

7.—(1) The following provisions of the Food Safety Act 1990⁽¹⁾ apply for the purposes of these Regulations, with reference in those provisions to the Act or a Part of it being construed as a reference to these Regulations—

- (a) section 20 (offences due to fault of another person);
- (b) section 21(1), (5) and (6) (defence of due diligence);
- (c) section 33 (obstruction etc of officers);
- (d) Section 34 of the Food Safety Act 1990 (time limit for prosecutions) applies to offences under regulations 6 as it applies to offences punishable under section 35(2).
- (e) section 35(1)⁽²⁾, (2) and (3)(b) (punishment of offences) in so far as it relates to offences under section 33 as applied by this regulation;
- (f) section 36 (offences by bodies corporate);
- (g) section 36A⁽³⁾ (offences by Scottish partnerships);
- (h) section 44 (protection of officers acting in good faith).
