The Avian Influenza (H5N1 in Poultry) (Wales) Order 2006

Establishment of a restricted zone on confirmation of avian influenza of subtype H5N1 in poultry

8.—(1) This article applies if the Chief Veterinary Officer confirms that—

- (a) highly pathogenic avian influenza virus of the H5 subtype is present in poultry or in a poultry carcase in Great Britain; and that
- (b) the neuraminidase virus type is N1.

(2) The National Assembly must declare a restricted zone under article 28(5) of the Avian Influenza Order if the poultry or carcase in which highly pathogenic avian influenza of subtype H5N1 is confirmed was found—

- (a) in Wales; or
- (b) in England, less than ten kilometres from the border with Wales.
