Title, commencement and application

- 1.—(1) The title of these Regulations is the National Health Service (Dental Charges) (Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2006 and they come into force on 15 December 2006.
 - (2) These Regulations apply in relation to Wales(2).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations correct an error in the National Health Service (Dental Charges) (Wales) Regulations 2006 (S.I. 2006/491 (W.60)) ("the 2006 Regulations").

Regulation 2 removes the reference to "crowns in other materials" in the list of appliances for which a Band 3 charge may be made and recovered in Schedule 3 to the 2006 Regulations.
