PART 4

PERSONS WHO PERFORM SERVICES

Dental care professionals

22.—(1) Prior to the coming into force of the first regulations under section 36A(2) of the Dentists Act⁽¹⁾ (professions complementary to dentistry)—

- (a) a dental hygienist; or
- (b) a dental therapist

may perform dental services under the contract provided he or she is enrolled in the appropriate register established in accordance with the Dental Auxiliaries Regulations 1986⁽²⁾.

(2) Upon the coming into force of the first regulations under section 36A(2) of the Dentists Act—

- (a) a dental hygienist;
- (b) a dental therapist; or
- (c) a professional or member of a class as specified in regulations made under section 36A(2) of the Dentists Act,

may perform dental services under the contract provided—

- (i) he or she is a dental care professional; and
- (ii) his or her registration in the dental care professional register established under section 36B⁽³⁾ of the Dentists Act is not subject to a suspension.
