**The Food for Particular Nutritional Uses
(Addition of Substances for Specific Nutritional
Purposes) (Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2007**

Made - - - - 23 January 2007
Coming into force - - 25 January 2007

The National Assembly for Wales makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 16(1)(f), 17(1), 26(3) and 48(1) of the Food Safety Act 1990(1) and now vested in it(2).

The National Assembly for Wales has had regard to relevant advice given by the Food Standards Agency as required by section 48(4A) of that Act.

There has been open and transparent public consultation during the preparation of the Regulations as required by Article 9 of Regulation (EC) No. 178/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down the general principles and requirements of food law, establishing the European Food Safety Authority and laying down procedures in matters of food safety(3).
