**The Animal Gatherings (Wales) Order 2007**

**Interpretation**

**2.** In this Order—

“animals” (“*anifeiliaid*”) means cattle (excluding bison and yak), deer, goats, sheep and pigs;

“animal area” (“*man i anifeiliaid*”) has the meaning given in article 5(3)(c);

“animal gathering” (“*crynhoad anifeiliaid*”) means an occasion at which animals are brought together for one or more of the following purposes—

- (a) a sale, show or exhibition,
- (b) onward consignment within Great Britain,
- (c) inspection to confirm the animals possess specific breed characteristics;

“approved disinfectant” (“*diheintydd a gymeradwywyd*”) means a disinfectant approved under the Diseases of Animals (Approved Disinfectants) Order 1978(1);

“equipment” (“*cyfarpar*”) includes pens and hurdles;

“licensed premises” (“*mangre drwyddedig*”) means premises licensed under article 5;

“paved” (“*palmantog*”) means paved with cement, concrete, asphalt or other hard, impermeable material that is capable of being effectively cleansed and disinfected;

“sheep autumn breeding sale” (“*arwerthiant defaid magu yn yr hydref*”) means an animal gathering held on a date between 1 August and 31 December for the primary purpose of the sale of breeding sheep.
