The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 8(1) of the Animal Health Act 1981⁽¹⁾, make the following Order:

Title and commencement

- 1.—(1) The title of this Order is the Disease Control (Wales) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 2007.
- (2) This Order applies in relation to Wales and comes into force at 12.00 noon on 8 September 2007.

Amendment

2. The Disease Control (Wales) Order 2003⁽²⁾ is amended by omitting article 3A.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Disease Control (Wales) Order 2003 (S.I.2003/1966 (W.211)) to remove the emergency measures that increase the standstill period from 6 to 20 days and disapply paragraph 8 of Schedule 1 and paragraph 13 of Schedule 2 in respect of certain movements in a sole occupancy group.

A regulatory impact assessment has not been prepared for this Order.
