**The Cattle Identification (Wales)
(Amendment) Regulations 2007**

The Welsh Ministers who are designated for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972⁽¹⁾ in relation to the common agricultural policy of the European Community⁽²⁾ and in relation to measures in the veterinary field for the protection of public health⁽³⁾, make the following Regulations.

Title, application and commencement

1. The title of these Regulations is the Cattle Identification (Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2007; they apply in relation to Wales and come into force on 14 November 2007.

Amendment to the Cattle Identification (Wales) Regulations 2007

2. The Cattle Identification (Wales) Regulations 2007⁽⁴⁾ are amended by adding after regulation 3(3) the following paragraph —

“(4) Any person who fails to comply with paragraph (1) or (3) is guilty of an offence.”
