## PART 1

## Interpretation

1. In this Schedule—

"boar" ("baedd") means a male pig after puberty, intended for breeding;

"gilt" ("banwes") means a female pig intended for breeding after puberty and before farrowing;

"piglet" ("porchell") means a pig from birth to weaning;

"rearing pig" ("*mochyn magu*") means a pig from the age of ten weeks to slaughter or service; "sow" ("*hwch*") means a female pig after the first farrowing;

"weaner" ("porchell diddwyn") means a pig from weaning to the age of ten weeks.
