Alert and information thresholds

PART 1

Alert thresholds for nitrogen dioxide and sulphur dioxide

Nitrogen dioxide	$400 \ \mu\text{g/m}^3$ measured over three consecutive hours at locations representative of air quality over at least 100 km ² or an entire zone or agglomeration, whichever is the smaller
Sulphur dioxide	$500 \ \mu\text{g/m}^3$ measured over three consecutive hours at locations representative of air quality over at least 100 km ² or an entire zone or agglomeration, whichever is the smaller

PART 2

Alert and information thresholds for ozone

	Parameter	Threshold	
Alert threshold	1-hour average ⁽¹⁾	$240 \ \mu g/m^3$	
Information threshold	1-hour average	$180 \ \mu g/m^3$	

(1) For the purposes of regulation 11 (action plans), exceedance of the 1-hour average in respect of the alert threshold is to be measured or predicted for three consecutive hours.
