**The Mental Health (Independent Mental
Health Advocates) (Wales) Regulations 2008**

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations —

“the Act” (“*y Ddeddf*”) means the Mental Health Act 1983;

“IMHA” (“*EAIM*”) means an independent mental health advocate;

“provider of advocacy services” (“*darparyydd gwasanaethau eirioli*”) means a body or person, including a voluntary organisation, that employs persons who may be made available to act as an IMHA;

“qualifying patients” (“*cleifion cymwys*”) mean those persons who qualify for help from an IMHA under sections 130C(2), (3) and (4) of the Act
