**The Tuberculosis (Testing and Powers of Entry) (Wales) Order 2008**

*Made* - - - - - *21 October 2008*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *22 October 2008*

The Welsh Ministers in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 62D of the Animal Health Act 1981 (1) make the following Order—

A draft of this Order was laid before the National Assembly for Wales under section 62D of the Animal Health Act 1981 and has been approved by a resolution of the National Assembly for Wales.

**Title, commencement and application**

1. The title of this Order is the Tuberculosis (Testing and Powers of Entry) (Wales) Order 2008; it applies in relation to Wales and comes into force on the day after it is made.

**Specification of “disease”**

2. Tuberculosis is specified as a disease (“*clefyd*”) for the purpose of section 62D (tests and samples: power of entry) of the Animal Health Act 1981.

This Order specifies tuberculosis as a disease for the purposes of section 62D of the Animal Health Act 1981.
