Mae'r Rheoliadau hyn yn diwygio Rheoliadau Addysg (Trefniadau Apelau Derbyn) (Cymru) 2005 O.S. 2005/1398 (Cy.112) ("Rheoliadau 2005") ac yn dod i rym ar 15 Gorffennaf 2009. Mae'r diwygiad yn rheoliad 2 yn gwneud newid technegol bychan yn Rheoliadau 2005, ac yn gosod y geiriau "awdurdod addysg lleol" yn lle'r geiriau "awdurdod lleol" yn Atodlen 2.

These Regulations amend the Education (Admission Appeals Arrangements) (Wales) Regulations 2005 S.I. 2005/1398 (W.112) ("the 2005 Regulations") and come into force on 15 July 2009. The amendment in regulation 2 makes a minor technical change to the 2005 Regulations and replaces the words "local authority" in Schedule 2 with "local education authority".

The Welsh Ministers in exercise of the powers conferred on the Secretary of State by sections 94(5A), 95(3A) and 138(7) and (8) of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998(1) and now vested in them(2), and after consultation with the Administrative Justice and Tribunals Council in accordance with Schedule 7 to the Tribunals, Courts and Enforcement Act 2007(3), make the following Regulations.

Title, Commencement and Application

1.—(1) The title of these Regulations is the Education (Admission Appeals Arrangements) (Wales) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2009, and they come into force on 15 July 2009.

(2) These Regulations apply in relation to Wales.

(1) 1998 p.31. Mewnsoodwyd is-adran 5A yn adran 94 gan adran 50 o Ddeddf Addysg 2002 (p.32). Mewnsoodwyd is-adran 3A yn adran 95 gan baragraff 9 o Atodlen 4 i Ddeddf Addysg 2002 (p.32).

(2) Trosglwyddwyd swyddogaethau'r Ysgrifennydd Gwladol o dan yr adrannau hyn i Gynulliad Cenedlaethol Cymru gan Orchymyn Cynulliad Cenedlaethol Cymru (Trosglwyddo Swyddogaethau) 1999 (O.S. 1999/672) ac wedyn i Weiniogion Cymru gan baragraff 30 o Atodlen 11 i Ddeddf Llywodraeth Cymru 2006 (p.32).

(3) 2007 p.15. Mae paragraff 24(1) o Atodlen 7 i Ddeddf Tribiwnlysoedd, Llysoedd a Gorfodi 2007 yn cyfarwyddo mai ar ôl ymgynghori â'r Cyngor, yn unig, y ceir arfer pŵer Gweinidogion Cymru i wneud, cymeradwyo, cadarnhau neu gysynio i reolau gweithdrefnol ar gyfer unrhyw driwlysoedd a restrir.

(1) 1998 c.31. Sub-section 5A was inserted into section 94 by section 50 of the Education Act 2002 (c.32). Sub-section 3A was inserted into section 95 by paragraph 9 of Schedule 4 to the Education Act 2002 (c.32).

(2) The functions of the Secretary of State under these sections were transferred to the National Assembly for Wales by the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999 (S.I. 1999/672) and then to the Welsh Ministers by paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c.32).

(3) 2007 c.15. Paragraph 24(1) of Schedule 7 to the Tribunals, Courts and Enforcement Act 2007 directs that the power of the Welsh Ministers to make, approve, confirm or concur in procedural rules for any listed tribunal is exercisable only after consultation with the Council.

Diwygio'r Rheoliadau

2.—(1) Diwygir Rheoliadau Addysg (Trefniadau Apelau Derbyn) (Cymru) 2005(1) fel a ganlyn.

(2) Yn Atodlen 2 i'r Rheoliadau, ym mhob man y mae'n digwydd—

yn lle "awdurdod lleol" gosoder "awdurdod addysg lleol".

Amendment of Regulations

2.—(1) The Education (Admission Appeals Arrangements) (Wales) Regulations 2005(1) are amended as follows.

(2) In Schedule 2 to the Regulations, in each place it occurs, replace—

"local authority" with "local education authority".
