# Appointment of representatives

### Appointment of representative

**12.** A supervisory body will appoint in writing as a representative for the relevant person any person who is selected in accordance with Part 4.

### Formalities of appointing a representative

- 13. Notice of the appointment of a representative must be given to the following persons—
  - (a) the relevant person;
  - (b) the relevant managing authority;
  - (c) any donee or deputy of the relevant person;
  - (d) any independent mental capacity advocate(1) appointed in accordance with the Act; and
  - (e) any person consulted by the best interest assessor.
