ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The M4 Motorway (Junction 32, Coryton Interchange, Cardiff) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2011

Made 21 January 2011
Coming into force 29 January 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the London to South Wales Motorway (M4) (hereinafter referred to as "the motorway"), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the motorway should be prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers (2) make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 29 January 2011 and its title is The M4 Motorway (Junction 32, Coryton Interchange, Cardiff) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2011.

2. (1) In this Order:

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

"the length of the motorway" ("y darn o'r draffordd") means that length of the main eastbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 32, Coryton Interchange, in the City and County of Cardiff which extends from a point where the eastbound off slip road diverges from the main carriageway of the motorway to a point where the eastbound on slip road merges with the main carriageway of the motorway;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means the period commencing at 20.00 hours on 29 January 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

- (2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- 3. Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the length of the motorway.
- 4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.
- 5. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 12 months.
