## **ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

The A483 Trunk Road (Ruabon Interchange (Junction 1), to Gresford Interchange (Junction 6), Wrexham) (Temporary 50 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2011

Made 16 June 2011
Coming into force 1 July 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Swansea – Manchester Trunk Road (A483) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted by reason of the likelihood of danger to the public.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 1 July 2011 and its title is The A483 Trunk Road (Ruabon Interchange (Junction 1), to Gresford Interchange (Junction 6), Wrexham) (Temporary 50 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2011.

### **2.**—(1) In this Order:

"the length of the trunk road" ("y darn o'r gefnffordd") means that length of the A483 Swansea to Manchester trunk road which extends from a point at its junction with the A539 at Ruabon Interchange (Junction 1), to the centre-point of Gresford Interchange (Junction 6), in the County Borough of Wrexham;

"restricted period" ("cyfnod y cyfyngiad") means the period commencing at 20:00 hours on 1 July 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

- (2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.
- **3.** Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall, during the restricted period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restriction referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.
- **5.** The maximum duration of this Order shall be 2 months.
