## **ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

The A40 Trunk Road (Llandovery Level Crossing, Llandovery, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2011

Made

26 August 2011

Coming into force

7 September 2011

The Welsh Ministers, as the traffic authority for the Swansea – Manchester Trunk Road (A40) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 7 September 2011 and its title is The A40 Trunk Road (Llandovery Level Crossing, Llandovery, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2011.

### **2.**—1) In this Order:

"the length of the trunk road" ("y darn o'r gefnffordd") means that length of the A40 trunk road at Llandovery Level Crossing at Llandovery, in the County of Carmarthenshire, that extends from a point approximately 20 metres either side of the said crossing;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means that period commencing at 20:00 hours on 7 September 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs have been removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

- **3.** Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any vehicle or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of the trunk road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.
- **5.** The maximum duration for this Order shall be 6 months.
