The A487 Trunk Road (Glandyfi
Improvement, Ceredigion)
(Temporary Traffic Prohibition and
Restrictions) Order 2011

Made 16 February 2011

Coming into force 25 February 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the A487 Fishguard to Bangor Trunk Road (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited and restricted by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon;

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers (2), make this Order:

1. This Order comes into force on 25 February 2011. The title to this Order is The A487 Trunk Road (Glandyfi Improvement, Ceredigion) (Temporary Traffic Prohibition and Restrictions) Order 2011.

2. —(1) In this Order:

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means the length of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the works giving rise to this Order or for emergency services;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 00.01 hours on 25 February 2010 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of Article 7, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour, in the length of the trunk road.
4. Subject to the provisions of Article 7, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour, in the length of the trunk road.
5. Subject to the provisions of Article 7, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour, in the length of the trunk road.
6. Subject to the provisions of Article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, in the length of the trunk road.
7. The provisions of Articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restriction referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.
8. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 18 months.

SCHEDULE

That length of the trunk road from a point 303 metres south of the centrepoint of the bridge carrying the A487 over the Afon Melindwr to a point 58 metres north of the unclassified road leading to Caerhedyn.
