The Children and Young Persons Act 2008 (Commencement No. 6) (Wales) Order 2011

Appointed days

- **3.**—(1) 28 March 2011 is the appointed day for the coming into force of the following provisions of the Act in relation to Wales—
 - (a) section 15 (duty of local authority to ensure visits to looked after children and others) in so far as it is not already in force(1);
 - (b) section 19 (support for accommodated children);
 - (c) section 29 (notification of matters relating to persons carrying on or managing children's homes etc) in so far as it is not already in force(2); and
 - (d) section 42 and Schedule 4 (repeals) in so far as they relate to—
 - (i) the repeal of the provisions of section 104 of the 1989 Act specified in that Schedule, and
 - (ii) the repeal of the provisions of section 21 of the 2000 Act(3) specified in that Schedule.
- (2) 1 September 2011 is the appointed day for the coming into force of section 20 of the Act (designated member of staff at school for pupils looked after by a local authority) in relation to Wales, in so far as it is not already in force(4).
