## The Children and Young Persons Act 2008 (Commencement No. 7) (Wales) Order 2012

## Appointed day

- **2.** 19 June 2012 is the appointed day for the coming into force of the following provisions of the Act in relation to Wales—
  - (a) section 22 (assistance to pursue education or training) in so far as it is not already in force(1),
  - (b) section 23 (extension of entitlements to personal adviser and to assistance in connection with education or training) in so far as it is not already in force(2),
  - (c) section 24 (extension of power to make payments in cash),
  - (d) section 25 (breaks from caring for disabled children) in so far as it is not already in force)(3), and
  - (e) section 42 and Schedule 4 (repeals) in so far as they relate to the repeal of the following provisions of the 1989 Act(4)—
    - (i) the words "in exceptional circumstances" in section 17(6),
    - (ii) sub-sections (4) to (7) of section 23B, and
    - (iii) in Schedule 2, in paragraph 6(1), the word "and" immediately preceding paragraph (b).
