**The A4042 Trunk Road & M4
Motorway (Grove Park Roundabout
to Caerleon Interchange, Newport)
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles)
Order 2012**

Made *9 February 2012*

Coming into force *20 February 2012*

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the Newport – Shrewsbury Trunk Road (A4042) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”) and the London – South Wales Motorway (M4) (hereinafter referred to as “the motorway”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road and motorway should be prohibited by reason of works being executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 20 February 2012 and its title is The A4042 Trunk Road & M4 Motorway (Grove Park Roundabout to Caerleon Interchange, Newport) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2012.

2. —(1) In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (*“cerbyd esempt”*) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the length of the trunk road” (*“y darn o’r cefnffordd”*) means the length of the A4042 trunk road in the City and County of Newport, which extends from a point at its junction with Grove Park Roundabout to a point at its junction with the circulatory carriageway of Caerleon Interchange Roundabout;

“the length of the motorway” (“*y darn o’r draffordd*”) means the entire length of the eastbound on slip road of the M4 motorway at Junction 25a in the City and County of Newport;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 20:00 hours on 20 February 2012 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed in the lengths of the trunk road and motorway.

4. The provisions of article 3 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

5. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.
