**The Apprenticeships (Specification of

The Welsh Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 28(3) of the Apprenticeships, Skills, Children and Learning Act 2009⁽¹⁾.

In accordance with section 28(5) of that Act, the Welsh Ministers are satisfied that the specification of apprenticeship standards given effect by this Order complies with section 31.

This is the first draft specification of apprenticeship standards to be prepared after the commencement of section 28 of that Act, and in accordance with section 28(4), the Welsh Ministers were not required to consult such persons as they think appropriate.

Title, commencement and application

1.—(1) The title of this Order is the Apprenticeships (Specification of Apprenticeship Standards for Wales) Order 2013 and it comes into force on 23 June 2013.

(2) This Order applies in relation to Wales.
