**The A465 Trunk Road (Gurnos
Lay-bys, Merthyr Tydfil)
(Prohibition of U-Turns) Order
2013**

Made 17 May 2013

Coming into force 23 May 2013

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A465 Neath to Abergavenny Trunk Road (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 1(1), 2(1) and 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984⁽¹⁾ and after consultation with the Chief Officer of the South Wales Police, make this Order:—

Title and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 23 May 2013. The title to this Order is the A465 Trunk Road (Gurnos Lay-bys, Merthyr Tydfil) (Prohibition of U-Turns) Order 2013.

Restriction

2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to make a U-Turn whilst proceeding in an eastbound or westbound direction on the trunk road at Gurnos, in the County Borough of Merthyr Tydfil, from a point 55 metres east from the midpoint of the Gurnos Road underbridge to a point 425 metres east from the midpoint of the Gurnos Road underbridge.

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, article 2 and Schedule 1, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006, these functions are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.
