**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

**The A48 Trunk Road (Pensarn  
Roundabout to Nant-y-Caws,  
Carmarthenshire) (Temporary  
Traffic Prohibitions & Restrictions)  
Order 2013**

*Made* 29 October 2013

*Coming into force* 4 November 2013

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the London – Fishguard Trunk Road (A48) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited and restricted by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

**Title, Interpretation and Commencement**

**1.** This Order comes into force on 4 November 2013 and its title is The A48 Trunk Road (Pensarn Roundabout to Nant-y-Caws, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Traffic Prohibitions & Restrictions) Order 2013.

**2.—(1)** In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (*“cerbyd esempt”*) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the lengths of the trunk road” (*“y darnau o’r gefnffordd”*) means those lengths of the A48 trunk road in the County of Carmarthenshire described in the Schedules to this Order;

“works period” (*“cyfnod y gwaith”*) means the period commencing at 00:01 hours on 4 November 2013 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

### **Prohibitions and Restrictions**

3. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.

6. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 during such times as the restriction referred to in article 5 is in operation.

### **Application**

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibitions and restrictions referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

### **Duration of this Order**

8. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 18 months.

## **SCHEDULES**

### **SCHEDULE 1**

#### **Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles**

The length of the trunk road that extends from the south-eastern side of Pensarn Roundabout to the centre-point of its junction with Heol Llangynnwr, Nant-y-Caws.

### **SCHEDULE 2**

#### **Temporary 40 mph & 10 mph Speed Limits & No Overtaking**

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 1.1 kilometres south-east of the centre-point of its junction with Pensarn Roundabout to the centre-point of its junction with Heol Llangynnwr, Nant-y-Caws.
