The A470 Trunk Road (Newbridge-on-Wye, Powys) (Temporary 30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2014

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Cardiff to Llangurig Trunk Road (A470) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted by reason of the likelihood of danger to the public.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1), (4) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2) make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 17 February 2014. Its title is The A470 Trunk Road (Newbridge-on-Wye, Powys) (Temporary 30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2014.

2. (1) In this Order:

"the length of the trunk road" ("*y* darn o'r gefnffordd") means the length of the trunk road at Newbridge-on-Wye in the County of Powys that extends from a point 153 metres north of its junction with Cyffredin Lane in a southerly direction to a point 250 metres south of its junction with Woodcastle Farm Road;

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Restriction

3. Subject to the provisions of article 5, no person shall drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the length of the Trunk Road.

Suspensions

4. The provisions of The Trunk Road (A470) (Newbridge-On-Wye, Powys) (Restricted Roads) Order 1991(3), insofar as they apply to the length of the trunk road specified in article 2(1), are hereby suspended during such times as the restriction specified in article 3 is in operation.

Application

5. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restriction referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

6.The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.
