**The A5 Trunk Road (South of  
Cerrigydrudion, Conwy)  
(Temporary Traffic Restrictions and  
No Overtaking) Order 2014**

*24 November 2014*

*Coming into force*

*1 December 2014*

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the London – Holyhead Trunk Road (A5) (“the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted and prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

**Title, Interpretation and Commencement**

**1.** This Order comes into force on 1 December 2014. The title to this Order is The A5 Trunk Road (South of Cerrigydrudion, Conwy) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions and No Overtaking) Order 2014.

**2.—(1)** In this Order:

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means that length of the trunk road south of Cerrigydrudion in the County Borough of Conwy which extends from a point 500 metres east of its junction with the unclassified road leading to Llangwm, in a north-westerly direction to its junction with the B4501;

“works period,” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 07.00 hours on 1 December 2014 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

### **Restrictions and Prohibition**

3. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour, in the length of the trunk road.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour, in the length of the trunk road.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the length of the trunk road, during such times as the restriction referred to in article 4 is in operation.

### **Application**

6. The provisions of article 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions and prohibition referred to therein are indicated by traffic signs.

### **Duration of this Order**

7. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 12 months.
