**The A470 Trunk Road (Bodnant,
Conwy County Borough)
(Temporary Speed Restrictions &
No Overtaking) Order 2015**

Made

30 June 2015

Coming into force

6 July 2015

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Maentwrog – East of Conwy Trunk Road (A470) (“the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted and prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 6 July 2015 and its title is The A470 Trunk Road (Bodnant, Conwy County Borough) (Temporary Speed Restrictions & No Overtaking) Order 2015.

2.—(1) In this Order:

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means the length of the trunk road at Bodnant in the County Borough of Conwy that extends in a southerly direction from its junction with the unclassified road known as Bodnant Road (leading to Bodnant Gardens) to its junction with the unclassified road known as Ty Gwyn Road;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 07:00 hours on 6 July 2015 and

ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Restrictions and Prohibition

3. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the length of the trunk road during such times as the restriction referred to in article 4 is in operation.

Application

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions and prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 12 months.
